Entry is open to all 3-12 year olds and there are five age categories.

- The Powder Monkeys (3 & 4 year-olds)
- The First Mates (5 & 6 year-olds)
- The Quartermasters (7 & 8 year-olds)
- The Navigators (9 & 10 year-olds)
- The Boatswains (10 & 12 year-olds)

ON THE DAY

Make sure you arrive in time to register (30-minutes before) and get your pirate crew number ready for the parade. Each age group will be called to the lawn to participate in a parade at the following times:

- II:10am II:20am The Powder Monkeys (3-4 year-olds)
- II:20am II:30am The First Mates (5-6 year-olds)
- II:30am II:40am The Quartermasters (7-8 year-olds)
- II:40am II:50am The Navigators (9-10 year-olds)
- II:50am I2:00pm The Boatswains (I0-I2 year-olds)

JUDGING

Captain Red Beard and a special guest will be judging and will award one winner from each age group category.

THE PRIZE

The winners of each age group will receive a family ticket (2x children and 2x adults) to sail on one of the Tall Ships visiting for the festival.

COMPETITION TERMS + CONDITIONS

- The competition is run by Royal Geelong Yacht Club.
- Competition opens 9am I6th February and closes 6pm 8th March 2024.
- The competition is a game of skill, judged on the best pirate hat designed within the competition period and displayed in the fashion parade on Sunday IIth March, 2024.
- Entry is open to children aged 3-12 years old.
- Only one competition entry per person.
- Judging will take place on Sunday 11th March, 2024 at the Wooden Boat Festival held at Royal Geelong Yacht Club. Judge's decision is final.

Five prizes will be awarded - one for each of the five age categories:

- II:10am II:20am The Powder Monkeys (3-4 year-olds)
- II:20am II:30am The First Mates (5-6 year-olds)
- II:30am II:40am The Quartermasters (7-8 year-olds)
- II:40am II:50am The Navigators (9-10 year-olds)
- II:50am I2:00pm The Boatswains (I0-I2 year-olds)

All winners will be notified on the day. If a winner is not present to receive their prize, the Judges will re-award this to the runner up.

PRIZE DETAILS

- The winner of each age group will receive a family ticket (2x children and 2x adults) to sail on one of the Tall Ships visiting for the Wooden Boat Festival, at 2pm on Sunday IIth March, 2024.
- Each prize is valued at \$105.
- The total prize pool is valued at \$525.
- Prizes are subject to availability and weather conditions on the day.
- No cash alternative for any prizes will be offered.
- Royal Geelong Yacht Club will not share entrants' personal details with third parties unless they have won a competition, in which case details may be published in local media or via the Royal Geelong **Yacht Club's communications channels - website, Facebook,** Instagram.
